



DUA FOR THE DECEASED

When the grave is leveled, any one may put his hand on it, open the fingers, press them on the grave, and pray for the dead person, saying:

أَللّٰهُمَّ أَنْسِ وَحْشَتَهُ وَأَرْحَمْ غُرْبَتَهُ وَأَسْكِنْ رَوْعَتَهُ
 وَصِلْ وَحْدَتَهُ وَأَسْكِنْ إِلَيْهِ مِنْ رَحْمَتِكَ رَحْمَةً يَسْتَغْفِنُ
 بِهَا عَنْ رَحْمَةِ مَنْ سِوَاكَ وَاحْشُرْهُ مَعَ مَنْ كَانَ يَتَوَلَّهُ

When people leave, the nearest relative of the dead person should remain there, praying Almighty Allah's mercy on the dead person. If nothing prevents from so, this person should call at the dead loudly and say these words:

يَا فُلَانِ بْنِ فُلَانِ اللَّهِ رَبِّكَ وَمُحَمَّدَ نَبِيُّكَ وَالْقُرْآنَ
 كِتَابُكَ وَالْكَعْبَةُ قِبْلَتُكَ وَعَلَىٰ إِمَامُكَ وَالْحَسَنُ وَ
 الْحَسِينُ———أَتَمَّتُكَ أَئِمَّةُ الْهُدَى الْأَبْرَارُ—
